Response to Questions

1. Has TCAG developed updated demographic profiles for the region and sub areas for this project? If so, will the profiles and raw data be provided to the consultant for consistency across the elements of the RTP/SCS?
 - TCAG is currently updating the demographic forecast and assembling a detailed demographic profile. Most of this should be in close to final form by the end of November. The data will be made available to the consultants.
2. What RTP/SCS community engagement has occurred to date? Will consultants have access to this data?
 - Outreach on the 2022 RTP/SCS has not yet begun in earnest; however, all information collected via TCAG's outreach during this process can be provided to the consultant.
3. What additional engagement activities will TCAG or other consultants be conducting for the RTP/SCS concurrently with engagement activities specific to the HIA/EJR consultant's activities? Will the consultant have access to these meetings and any resulting data?
 - TCAG has robust outreach and engagement processes. We focus on ensuring a variety of methods are used. In the past we have gone to community events (fairs, festivals), hosted public workshops, developed stakeholder committees, utilized extensive social media, and more. Outreach methodology will change somewhat from prior methods, perhaps focusing more heavily on electronic communications, but will still be robust. Any outreach information collected via the RTP/SCS process will be made available to the consultant.
4. Will TCAG staff be available as additional support for engagement? For example, to identify stakeholder groups and community leaders, to support communications and outreach efforts, or for translation and interpretation.
 - TCAG will be happy to assist in support items such as these. TCAG has a translator on staff and will also facilitate communication with organizations and persons in the region with whom we work and have developed relationships.
