#### 1. Welcome & Introductions

Meeting opened by Chair Macaulay at 8:37am.

#### 2. Public Comments

Unscheduled comments are limited to 3 minutes. Note: Prior to the action by the Committee on any item on this agenda, the public may comment on that item. Public comments opened/closed at 8:39am. No public comments were heard.

#### 3. Action: Approval of Meeting Minutes for December 6, 2018 (Attached)

An error was identified in the minutes regarding the attendance of Chair Macaulay; he was present for the meeting. Member Ramirez moved to approve the minutes as amended, and they were seconded by Member Camarena. Minutes were approved unanimously.

#### 4. Information: Rocky Hill (east of Exeter) Bike & Pedestrian Path Feasibility Study Update

Chair Macaulay shared his knowledge regarding the meeting he attended with 4Creeks and reported that progress was being made and that the preferred option was to put bikes and cars on the road together and separate pedestrians.

#### 5. Multi-modal Outreach and Safety Program Update

Staff Brideget Moore provided an update regarding outreach efforts, highlighting the outcomes of the Ivanhoe Community Workshop in September and passed around the report generated from that event.

# 6. Information: Tulare County Public Health Bicycle and Pedestrian Fatality Update

Member Minnick provided a handout indicating 2018 fatalities. She indicated that fatalities were down from the previous year but had increased since 2014 and agreed to include a map of locations for the next meeting.

## 7. Information: Active Transportation Program (ATP) Update

Staff Gabriel Gutierrez shared that no Tulare County projects were selected in the last round. He stated that the MPO components were starting up and it could possibly be an opportunity to get some projects funded. Mr. Gutierrez reported that scores should be in by Feb 8th and in to CTC by Feb 15th and that he was discussing with CTC contacts about consulting with agencies regarding applications to give tips and advice, visit the sites and beef up the next round of applications possibly to take place in the spring or summer.

# 8. Information: Visalia Waterways and Trails Committee Update

No report was provided.

## 9. Caltrans District 6 Update

Member Ramirez stated that he was working on the bike plan with a goal to finish by the end of the fiscal year. He shared that Bakersfield is proposing a north/south trail and Fresno had just approved a class one bike lane on a canal bank. Discussion ensued regarding safety and buffer zones on those types of lanes.

#### **10.** Other Business

Staff Roberto Brady reported that Measure R funding was steady and TCAG was looking at the 19/20 budget after discussion ensued regarding Measure R's funded projects.

Staff Brideget Moore shared that the Local Motion Awards luncheon will take place the following day and invited everyone to attend.

Member Camarena shared information regarding Senior Games; an event March 31st for those 50 year of age and over.
