#### **SUMMARY MEETING MINUTES**

#### 1. Welcome & Introductions

Vice-Chair Camarena opened the meeting at 8:36 a.m. Committee member present were Vice-Chair Camarena, and Members Wallis-Dutra, Mello, Wall, Tree, Beal, Member Ramirez, and Alternate Member Keenan (in place of Member Senteno). TCAG Staff Members Brady, Kimball, Moore, Quintanilla, Gallo, Bhongir, and Gutierrez were also in attendance.

#### 2. Public Comments

This portion of the meeting is reserved for persons wishing to address the TCAG Active Transportation Advisory Committee on items within its purview but not on this agenda. Unscheduled comments are limited to 3 minutes. Note: Prior to the action by the Committee on any item on this agenda, the public may comment on that item.

Public comments opened at 8:37 a.m. There no public comments received. Public comments closed at 8:38 a.m.

#### 3. Action: Selection of Chair to replace outgoing Chair Ted Macauley.

Vice-Chair Camarena stated that the Committee is still looking for volunteers to fill the position of Committee Chair. After some discussion, Member Wall made a motion to nominate Vice-Chair Camarena as Chair and nominated himself to become the Vice-Chair. Member Tree

seconded the motion. The committee unanimously approved the selection of Mike Camarena as Chair and Mark Wall as Vice-Chair.

#### 4. Action: Approval of Meeting Minutes for January 28, 2021.

Upon motion by Member Wallis-Dutra and seconded by Vice-Chair Wall, the committee unanimously approved the minutes of January 28, 2021.

#### 5. Information: Project Implementation Status Update

Mr. Gutierrez stated that there was nothing new to report to the Committee at this time and the Mr. Smalley would likely provide a project implementation status update at the next ATAC meeting in March.

Mr. Kimball informed the Committee about the work that Ms. Bhongir will be performing in her role with TCAG. Ms. Bhongir's role will revolve heavily around active transportation and supporting the Committee in its function to inform and support active transportation efforts around the County. Mr. Kimball also addressed the Committee on the upcoming RTP roundtable meetings and the emphasis of active transportation as an increasingly major component of our overall transportation system.

Member Tree informed the Committee about the City of Porterville's recent ATP grant award for their Butterfield Stage Corridor project.

### 6. Information: ATP Program Update

Mr. Gutierrez reiterated to the Committee the great news about Porterville's ATP grant award for its Butterfield Stage Corridor project. He also informed the Board that MPO component scoring committee will begin reviewing and scoring projects unsuccessful on the Statewide component for funding available in the MPO Component. Staff hopes to present the list of recommended to the Committee in March.

## 7. Information: Tulare County Public Health Bicycle and Pedestrian Fatality Update

No report was provided.

#### 8. Information: Caltrans District 6 Update

Member Ramirez talked about the California Active Transportation Plan. Plan kick-off for District 6 planned in April-May timeframe. Seeking input from the public and stakeholders. Could take between 9 months and a year to complete the plan process.

Member Ramirez spoke briefly about the Ivanhoe active transportation project submitted by Caltrans. Even though it was not recommended for funding, Caltrans continues to plan to implement the project in the future.

#### 9. Information: CHP Update

Member Beal spoke about issues regarding CHP's enforcement efforts related to unsheltered individuals. CHP has been given to the green light to become more proactive in their enforcement efforts with the goal of lessening the occurrence of fatal incidents involving unsheltered individuals.

#### 10. Information: Active Transportation Outreach Update

Ms. Moore talked about the new public outreach platform TCAG will utilize to reach out to the public and constituents. Stated TCAG is in the middle of the Unmet Transit Needs process which is being noticed through both regular outreach channels as well as on social media.

Vice-Chair Wall asked if there is a way for a member of the public to request agencies to look at the performance of intersections from the perspective of operations and safety.

Member Wallis-Dutra described the requirements agencies must abide by with respect to inquiries from the public and the technical requirements for designing and improving intersections. Also discussed bicycle detection loops and where they are required and located.

#### 11. Other Business

Vice-Chair Wall updated the Committee on the Great Central Valley Bike Route (GCVBR). Plans are currently at about 90% complete. Vice-Chair Wall said he would be driving the proposed route through Tulare County in the coming days. Lastly, he stated that Mr. Smiley with the GCVBR would be available to update the Committee if requested.

#### 12. Adjourn

Meeting adjourned at 9:08 a.m.
