SUMMARY MEETING MINUTES

1. Call to Order & Welcome

Meeting opened at 12:38 pm.

2. Action: Approval of Summary Meeting Minutes

Minutes approval was motioned by Michael Navarro and seconded by Nick Mascia and approved unanimously.

3. Public Comments

No Public comments at this time

4. Information and discussion

Mark Hays gave a presentation regarding the 2018 Intersection Monitoring Report. He stated he would take suggestions for changes until the end of the month. None of the intersections met warrants. Mulberry Ave at Newcomb, Ave 256 at Rd 204, and Ave 416 and Road 104 were the only ones that failed, Tested State Route

65 and Firebaugh. Mitigation measures for each intersection were described as well as the effect of the mitigation. Mike Winton mentioned a project had been approved to add left hand turn lanes and signalize the intersection at Road 204 and Avenue 256.

5. Information

Mark Hays informed the committee that TCAG had entered into a new agreement with Metro Traffic data for traffic data collection. Also, fiscal year 2017 travel time data, as well as a technical support agreement had been purchased from Iteris Inc. It was also mentioned that there would not be an Intersection Monitoring Report completed during 2019.

7. Other Business

Mark Hays asked Michael Navarro if Caltrans would have anything to report to the TCAG Board. Michael Navarro replied that he would be giving Gail Miller follow-up information regarding Travel Time reports to advance to the Board.

Michael Winton asked what needed to be done to have Jabed Kahn replaced by him in the CMP Committee. Mark Hays replied that he should have his supervisor forward an email advising of the change in membership.

Nick Mascia advised the committee on the status of current projects within the city of Visalia, including the completion of improvements at the intersection of Goshen Avenue and Demaree Street, rehabilitation of Akers at SR-198, the design for the roundabout at Santa Fe and Tulare Street, rehabilitation of Lovers Lane at SR-198, as well as intersections along the soon-to-be-completed Caldwell Avenue. Roberto Brady asked about the Sequoia Gateway project. Nick confirmed that the project had been approved, and stated that a few intersections would be improved as a result of that project. He also stated that intersections at Walnut and Shirk should meet warrants by 2021 without it. He also advised signals would be going in at Mooney at Riggin, and County Center and Houston.

Michael Winton added that final paving on Caldwell Avenue was almost complete.

Mike Camarena stated that the roundabout which is under construction at Hermosa and Westwood is almost completed through phase 1, and will be going into phase 2.

Frank Senteno stated the city of Visalia was starting ICE at Akers and SR 198 using a warm mix from Vulcan Materials, and wanted to know if anyone had used it. There were no affirmative answers.
