SUMMARY MEETING MINUTES

A. Call to Order & Welcome

The Congestion Management Process (CMP) Steering Committee was called to order by Chair Mascia at 12:32 p.m. on September 21, 2017 at the Tulare County Association of Governments, 210 N. Church Street, Suite B, Visalia, CA 93291.

B. Action: Approval of Summary Meeting Minutes-Meeting for September 14, 2017

Upon a motion, by Member Reed, and seconded by Member Hays, the Congestion Management Program (CMP) Steering Committee unanimously approved the September 14, 2017 Summary Meeting Minutes.

C. Public Comments

Public comments were opened/closed at 12:33 p.m. No public comments were received.

D. Review: Draft 2017 Intersection Monitoring Report and Appendices. Member Hays stated that accident reports are not considered as part of the Intersection Monitoring Report. Member Hays reviewed the intersections in the report that were failing and also possible mitigation measures. Member Reed asked where the report would be taking us. Member Hays stated that the report results were to be used for consideration for funding projects and improvements and would be submitted to the TCAG Board for approval. Member Mascia provided details about the on-going project at the intersection of Goshen Avenue and Demaree Street.

Vice-Chair Hays submitted the draft CMP Guidelines so they could be adopted by the TCAG board in October. He reported that he had removed term limits and add proxy voting subject to prior notice by the CMP member agency, as recommended by Committee membership.

Upon a motion, by Member Hays, and seconded by Member Reed, the Congestion Management Program (CMP) Steering Committee unanimously approved the draft CMP Steering Committee Guidelines.

F. Information: Update: iPeMS Third Party Internet Application

Vice-Chair Hays stated the purchase of the iPeMs internet application was to be approved the September Board Meeting and asked for a confirmation of the next travel time reports being for the Mooney Blvd Corridor from Main Street to SR-137, and the SR-137 corridor from SR-99 to Hisperia in Lindsay. He stated that he should have something by the December meeting.

G. Discussion: Incorporating GPS coordinates into all traffic count spreadsheets. Vice-Chair Hays asked if the cities, when they have traffic counts/surveys performed, if they could incorporate GPS coordinates into them. This would allow them to be geocoded and posted on-line into a map.

H. Other Business:

Member Hays reported that the Tulare County Urban Area Intelligent Transportation Strategic Development Plan should be completed in a couple of months.

b. Information: Items from Committee Members

Member Mascias reported that a grand opening would be taking place for the City of Visalia's Traffic Control Center. He stated that there has been no movement at this time concerning transit priority, although there has been some discussion about doing it.

It was asked if staff could forward the HPMS data to member agencies again. Member Hays stated he would have Philip forward it.
