#### **Summary Meeting Minutes**

The Sustainable Corridor Committees (SCCs) Joint Meeting was called to order by the Committee Chair, Dennis Townsend at 10:05 a.m. on October 13, 2022. Public Comments opened/closed at 10:20 a.m.

Minutes for January 20, 2022 were approved upon a motion by Member Flores, and second by Member Schoettler.

Curt Hatton from Caltrans provided an update on the Clean California Tier 2 Local Grant Program and Caltrans's efforts of removing litter, creating jobs, educating the public, and engaging the community to transform unsightly roadsides into spaces of pride for all Californians. He also discussed Adopt-A-Highway program and presented how individuals,

organizations, or businesses could help maintain sections of roadside within California's State Highway System. In addition, he mentioned Litter Collection opportunities and how to beautify our region's transportation network through art and litter clean-up projects.

Member J. Ridenour presented current City of Porterville efforts for Litter Abetment partnership with Caltrans and CSET.

B. Cole, landscape architect with Caltrans District 6, provided an update on roadside design features and screening projects techniques for nominated in Tier 1 screening projects. He highlighted a few specific projects in the city of Porterville that Caltrans is currently working on planting and irrigation plans. He mentioned that plans are completed and only the minor change to irrigation needs to be done.

Members discussed remaining from the "master project list" concepts - the chain-link replacement project East of SR 198 and Berry Drive Interchange landscaping. They agreed that this discussion should continue.

K. Poleszczuk presented an idea of engaging consulting firm to prepare the Corridor Beautification Plan for Tulare County Region like the SR 99 Plan that was originally prepared. Members agreed this topic should be farther evaluated and discussed.

SCCs members provided updates on current agencies efforts to beautify highways in Tulare County.

Committee members discussed a date for the next meeting, which was tentatively set for the February 9th, 2023.

The SCCs Joint Meeting adjourned at 11:45 a.m.
