SUBJECT:

Action: Reaffirm Conditions of State Assembly Bill 361 to Continue Remote Attendance at Public Meetings

BACKGROUND:

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Governor suspended part of the Brown Act concerning the requirements for allowing Governing Board members to remotely participate in Board meetings. The suspended provisions require that (1) Governing Board meeting agendas allowing remote Board Member participation list each of the specific locations from which Board members will be remotely participating, (2) such agendas be posted at each such location, and (3) members of the general public must be allowed to remotely participate in the meeting from each of the listed locations. The suspension was done to promote social distancing and so to help limit the spread of COVID-19.

DISCUSSION:

The Governor's suspension of these Brown Act provisions expired as of September 30 and was replaced by new AB 361, an urgency statute that became effective as of September 30. Under AB 361, Governing Boards can continue to allow remote Board members participation in Brown Act public meetings if several conditions are met:

- 1. The meeting is held during a declared State of Emergency (Like the Governor's COVID-19 pandemic State of Emergency that's still in effect in California):
- 2. The Governing Board adopts findings to the effect that allowing remote meeting participation by Governing Board members promotes social distancing, which in turn helps prevent the spread of COVID-19;
- The Governing Board confirms these conditions continue to be met every 30 days.

The Tulare County Transportation Authority Board of Governors passed a resolution adopting a policy of remote attendance pursuant to AB 361 on October18, 2021.

RECOMMENDATION:

Reaffirm the decision to continue allowing the option to participate in its governing board meetings remotely through the use of the teleconferencing provisions of AB 361.

SUBJECT:

Adoption of Resolution: Update No. 2 to Measure R Sales Tax Data Access

BACKGROUND:

On November 7, 2006, the voters of Tulare County approved Measure R, imposing a ½-cent sales tax for transportation within the incorporated and unincorporated area of Tulare County through 2037. The transportation sales tax funds are spent in accordance with the Expenditure Plan that resulted from a joint effort among all the cities and the County of Tulare. The Expenditure Plan reflects the transportation needs of the residents of Tulare County. The plan includes funding for Regional Projects, Local Programs, Transit/Bike/Environmental Programs and Administration. The funds are distributed as follows:

- 1. Regional Projects (50%)
- 2. Local Programs (35%)
- 3. Transit/Bike/Environmental (14%)
- 4. Administration and Planning Program (1%)

Measure R revenue collection began on April 1, 2007. Monthly Measure R advancements are received by TCAG from the State Board of Equalization followed by quarterly clean-up disbursements. In total, TCAG receives eight advancements and four clean-up disbursements throughout a fiscal year.

The Measure R 2018 Strategic Work Plan was approved by the Authority on June 18, 2018 with Resolution No. 2018-102. The Work Plan serves as a guide for the delivery of Measure R projects in the upcoming five-year period. The 2018 Strategic Work Plan was amended on March 18, 2019 with Resolution No. 2019-104 and on April 15, 2019 with Resolution No. 2019-105.

The Measure R Sales Tax Data Access was updated on September 21, 2020 with Resolution No. 2020-116 to include access for our tax consultant, MuniServices, LLC (AVENU/MuniServices) and specific TCAG positions, i.e. Executive Director, Deputy Executive Director, Finance Director.

DISCUSSION:

Pursuant to Resolution No. 2010-0315 dated April 27, 2010, the employees in the following positions are authorized to have access to state database: Deputy Executive Director, Measure R Coordinator, and Executive Secretary. A general update to the individuals authorized to have access and give access to the sales tax information of TCTA is applicable at this time. This is to allow the Finance Director, who is the Measure R Coordinator, to have access. Currently when access requests are made by the Finance Director to CDTFA there is confusion on the title, the Measure R Coordinator is not included in the official Human Resources Title of Finance Director and therefore hinders access. It is also timely to add our tax consultant, MuniServices, LLC (Avenu/MuniServices). Whereas this is consistent with previous authorizations.

California Department of Tax and Fee Administration (CDTFA) has requested that in order to satisfy the requirements of section 7056, the original updated agreement should be amended, this requires that the TCTA governing body adopt a resolution requesting that persons duly authorized by TCTA and/or identified in the resolution (i.e., MuniServices LLC) be permitted to examine all of the sales tax records held by the SBE/CDTA pertaining to the collection of the Measure R sales tax. The resolution shall certify that any person designated by the resolution, other than an officer or employee of TCTA, meets all of the following conditions:

- (A) Has an existing contract with TCTA to examine those sales and use tax records;
- (B) Is required by that contract to disclose information contained in, or derived from, those sales or transactions and use tax records only to an officer or employee of TCTA who is authorized by the resolution to examine the information;
- (C) Is prohibited by that contract from performing consulting services for a retailer during the term of that contract; and
- (D) Is prohibited by that contract from retaining the information contained in, or derived from, those sales or transactions and use tax records, after that contract has expired.

TCAG staff conferred with legal and the attached document is a reflection of the approved language to be included in the agreement.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is staffs' recommendation to update the attached resolution to include appropriate staff to have access and designate, and to allow access to the newly appointed tax consultant.

RESOLUTION NO.

A Resolution of the Tulare County Transportation Authority Authorizing the Examination of Sales or Transactions and Use Tax Records

WHEREAS, pursuant to Tulare County Transportation Authority ("TCTA") Ordinance No. 2006-01, (TCTA entered into a contract with the State Board of Equalization to perform all functions incident to the administration and collection of TCTA's Measure R Transactions and Use Tax Ordinances and the local sales and use taxes; and

WHEREAS, TCTA deems it necessary for authorized representatives of TCTA to examine confidential sales and transactions and use tax records of the Board or its successor agency, the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration, (collectively, or in the alternative, the "Agency") pertaining to Measure R sales and transactions and use taxes collected for TCTA by the Agency; and

WHEREAS, Section 7056 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code sets forth certain requirements and conditions for the disclosure of Agency records and establishes criminal penalties for the unlawful disclosure of information contained in, or derived from sales or transactions and use tax records of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, Section 7056(b) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code requires that any person designated by TCTA to examine TCTA's sales and transactions and use tax records and who is not an officer or employee of TCTA must (1) have an existing contract to examine such records; must be required by that contract to disclose information contained in, or derived from, those sales or transactions and use tax records only to an officer or employee of TCAG who is authorized by the resolution to examine the information; (3) must be prohibited by that contract from performing consulting services for a retailer during the term of that contract; and (4) must be prohibited by that contract from retaining the information contained in, or derived from, those sales or transactions and use tax records, after that contract has expired.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That TCTA's Finance Director, or other officer or employee of TCTA designated in writing by the TCTA Finance Director to the Agency is hereby appointed to represent TCTA with authority to examine all of the sales and transactions and use tax records of the Agency pertaining to the Measure R sales and transactions and use taxes collected for TCTA by the Agency pursuant to the contract between TCTA and the Agency. The information obtained by examination of Agency records shall be used for purposes related to the collection of TCTA's Measure R sales and transactions and use taxes by the Agency pursuant to the contract.

Section 2. That the TCTA Finance Director, or other officer or employee of TCTA designated in writing by the TCTA Finance Director to the Agency, is also hereby appointed to represent TCTA with the authority to examine those Measure R sales and transactions and use tax records of the Agency for purposes related to the following governmental functions of TCTA:

- b) forecasting and budget related functions
- c) detection of misallocations and deficiencies

The information obtained by examination of Agency records shall be used only for those governmental functions of TCTA listed above.

Section 3. That MuniServices, LLC is hereby designated and authorized to examine all of the sales and transactions and use tax records of the Agency pertaining to all Measure R sales and use taxes collected for TCTA and any transaction and use taxes collected for TCTA under the following Transactions and Use Tax Ordinances and any future Transactions and Use Tax Ordinances that may be enacted, extended, or modified in TCTA:

Tulare County Transportation Authority Retail Transactions and Use Tax for Transportation Purposes (Measure R) .50% – TAC 162

MuniServices LLC meets all of the following conditions required by Revenue and Taxation Code section 7056(b) in that it:

- a) has an existing contract with TCTA to examine Measure R sales and transactions and use tax records;
- b) is required by that contract to disclose information contained in, or derived from those sales and transactions and use tax records only to an officer or employee of TCTA authorized under Section 1 (or Section 2) of this resolution to examine the information;
- c) is prohibited by that contract from performing consulting services for a retailer during the term of that contract;
- d) is prohibited by that contract from retaining the information contained in or derived from those sales and transactions and use tax records after that contract has expired.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the information obtained by examination of Agency records shall be used only for purposes related to the collection of TCTA's Measure R sales and transactions and use taxes by the Agency pursuant to the contracts between TCTA and the Agency and for purposes relating to the governmental functions of TCTA listed in Section 2 of this resolution.

Section 4. This resolution supersedes all prior sales and transactions and use tax resolutions of TCTA adopted pursuant to subdivision (b) of Revenue and Taxation Code Section 7056.

Information: Measure R Update and Revenues for October, November and December 2021

BACKGROUND:

On November 7, 2006, the voters of Tulare County approved Measure R, imposing a ½-cent sales tax for transportation within the incorporated and unincorporated area of Tulare County through 2037. The transportation sales tax funds are spent in accordance with the Expenditure Plan that resulted from a joint effort among all the cities and the County of Tulare. The Expenditure Plan reflects the transportation needs of the residents of Tulare County. The plan includes funding for Regional Projects, Local Programs, Transit/Bike/Environmental Programs and Administration. The funds are distributed as follows:

- 1. Regional Projects (50%)
- 2. Local Programs (35%)
- 3. Transit/Bike/Environmental (14%)
- 4. Administration and Planning Program (1%)

Measure R revenue collection began on April 1, 2007. Monthly Measure R advancements are received by TCAG from the State Board of Equalization followed by quarterly clean-up disbursements. In total, TCAG receives eight advancements and four clean-up disbursements throughout a fiscal year.

The Measure R 2020 Strategic Work Plan was approved by the Authority on October 19, 2020 with Resolution No. 2020-119, amended on December 14, 2020 with Resolution No. 2020-120, amended on April 19, 2021 with Resolution No. 2021-100 and amended August 26, 2021 with Resolution No. 2021-106.

DISCUSSION

MEASURE R UPDATE

Over the past year, the cost of construction continues to rise. There have been many reports in the news about the cost of inflation. Also, costs are likely to continue to rise. The increased costs have a direct impact on the number and timing of projects that can be built. Over the next few months, TCAG will be working with member agencies and Caltrans to review revised costs estimates and develop an action plan to continue delivering critical transportation projects throughout the county. One of the alternatives will be to evaluate dedicating a percentage of STGBG federal funds to regional projects.

Status of Measure R Revenues

Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Measure R allocations have been received, payment request and distribution made through December 2022. The allocation for the month of October is \$4,442,594, November is \$4,016,372 and December is \$3,492,613. The 21/22 fiscal

year to date amount is \$24,485,338 compared to \$20,207,977 for the same period last year representing a 21% increase thus far for the 21/22 fiscal year.
