SUBJECT:

Action: Adoption of Resolution: 2020 Measure R Strategic Work Plan – Amendment No. 3

BACKGROUND:

The Measure R Expenditure Plan serves as a guide for the use of transportation funds that will be generated through the Tulare County half-cent transportation sales tax through 2037. The Expenditure Plan was developed by the Tulare County Association of Governments and its nine member agencies (Dinuba, Exeter, Farmersville, Lindsay, Porterville, Tulare, Visalia, Woodlake, and the County of Tulare) and approved by the voters in November 2006. The Expenditure Plan represents diverse community interests and addresses major regional transportation needs in Tulare County through the year 2037. The Plan provides a detailed blueprint that will allow for the leveraging of state and federal funds through the revenues that are received through Measure R. The Plan provides funds for regional road improvements, public transit, rehabilitation of existing roads, and other transportation programs that will improve mobility and air quality within the County and each of the cities.

The Measure R Strategic Work Plan is the master plan for the delivery of Measure R projects over a five-year period. The 2020 plan was approved with Resolution No. 2020-119 at the October 1, 2020 Board meeting and Amendment No.1 was approved with Resolution No. 2020-120 on December 14, 2020 and Amendment No. 2 was approved with Resolution No. 2021-100 on April 19, 2021. It details the revenue projections and possible financing tools needed to deliver Measure R projects. It takes into consideration the Measure R Expenditure Plan and the Measure R Policies and Procedures and gathers them into one document that will produce Measure R projects in a timely and efficient manner. The Strategic Work Plan is updated every two years and amended when there are financial changes that affect the member agencies.

DISCUSSION:

This discussion serves as a reaffirmation of the Measure R funding for the Litter Abatement Pilot Program for the City of Porterville presented on May 17, 2021 and approved with Resolution No. 2021-101. Funding for the project comes from the City of Porterville general fund and the City of Porterville Measure R SR 190 corridor improvement funding within the Strategic Work Plan. Additionally, reaffirmation of the bike funding allocations of \$50K for City of Dinuba for El Monte Way. The project between Alta Ave and Road 92, will construct sidewalks, enhanced bike lanes, upgraded ADA ramps, two PHBs and pedestrian countdown signal heads. Approximately 1.5 miles in length. Staff anticipates the project will receive State ATP funds.

\$50K for City of Visalia Goshen Trail - Reconstruction of a 6.1 mile Class 1 multi-use trail, from Camp Drive to Giddings Avenue along the Goshen Avenue alignment. The project will extend and widen the existing trail. Staff anticipates the project will receive State ATP funds.

\$50K for City of Porterville Putnam and Elderwood - Installation of curb, gutter, sidewalk with landscape strip, streetlights and lighted crossing system in the recently annexed area of Putnam Avenue and Elderwood Street. Approximately a quarter mile in length including improvements along both sides of Putnam Avenue. Staff anticipates the project will receive State ATP funds.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Reaffirm funding for the Porterville Litter Abatement Pilot Program from the SR 190 Corridor improvement funding, and allocations to City of Dinuba for El Monte Way, City of Visalia for Goshen Trail and City of Porterville for Elderwood and Putnam within Strategic Work Plan.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No fiscal impact, funding is already allocated within the expenditure plan.

SUBJECT:

Information: Measure R Revenues for June-July 2021 and Audit Engagement Information

BACKGROUND:

On November 7, 2006, the voters of Tulare County approved Measure R, imposing a ½-cent sales tax for transportation within the incorporated and unincorporated area of Tulare County through 2037. The transportation sales tax funds are spent in accordance with the Expenditure Plan that resulted from a joint effort among all the cities and the County of Tulare. The Expenditure Plan reflects the transportation needs of the residents of Tulare County. The plan includes funding for Regional Projects, Local Programs, Transit/Bike/Environmental Programs and Administration. The funds are distributed as follows:

1. Regional Projects (50%)
2. Local Programs (35%)
3. Transit/Bike/Environmental (14%)
4. Administration and Planning Program (1%)

Measure R revenue collection began on April 1, 2007. Monthly Measure R advancements are received by TCAG from the State Board of Equalization followed by quarterly clean-up disbursements. In total, TCAG receives eight advancements and four clean-up disbursements throughout a fiscal year.

The Measure R 2020 Strategic Work Plan was approved by the Authority on October 19, 2020 with Resolution No. 2020-119, amended on December 14, 2020 with Resolution No. 2020-120, and amended on April 19, 2021 with Resolution No. 2021-100.

DISCUSSION:

Status of Measure R Revenues

Fiscal Year 2020/2021 and 2021/2022 - Measure R allocations have been received, payment request and distribution made through July 2021. The allocation for the month of June is \$3,675,601 compared to \$2,284,607 for the same period last year. The allocation for the month of July is \$4,884,538 compared to \$ 3,412,452 for the same period last year. The 20/21 fiscal year to date amount is \$41,583,953 compared to \$34,093,591 for the same period last year, representing a 22% increase for the fiscal year.

The 21/22 fiscal year to date amount is 4,884,538 compared to \$3,412,452 for the same period last year representing a 43% increase thus far for the new fiscal year.

The Agreement with Brown Armstrong is signed and we have begun the audit process for FY 2020/2021. Today I have distributed the attached communication letter from Brown Armstrong to each board member which outlines their responsibility, scope and time line of the audit.

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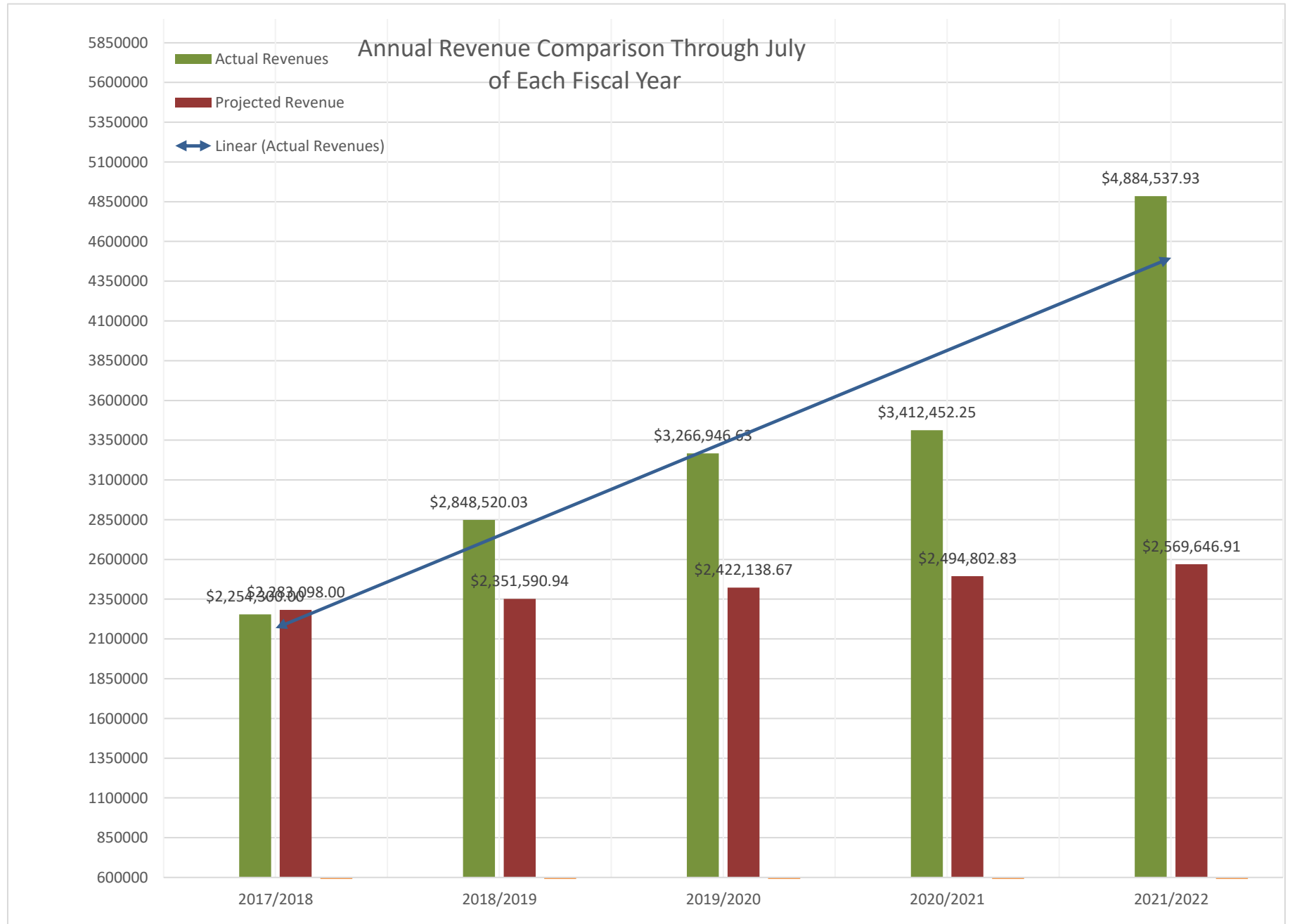

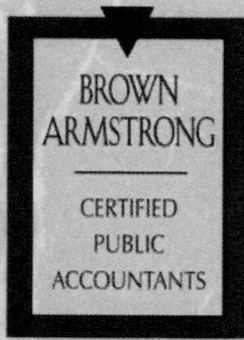

We are engaged to audit the financial statements of the governmental activities and the Measure R fund of Tulare County Transportation Authority (the Authority), a component unit of the Tulare County Association of Governments, Visalia, California, for the year ended June 30, 2021. Professional standards require that we provide you with the following information related to our audit. We would also appreciate the opportunity to meet with you to discuss this information further since a two-way dialogue can provide valuable information for the audit process.

Our Responsibility under Auditing Standards Generally Accepted in the United States of America

As stated in our engagement letter dated August 2, 2021, our responsibility, as described by professional standards, is to express opinions about whether the financial statements prepared by management with your oversight are fairly presented, in all material respects, in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Our audit of the financial statements does not relieve you or management of your responsibilities.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America provide for certain required supplementary information (RSI) to supplement the basic financial statements. Our responsibility with respect to the RSI, which supplements the Authority's basic financial statements, is to apply certain limited procedures in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. However, the RSI will not be audited and, because the limited procedures do not provide us with sufficient evidence to express an opinion or provide any assurance, we will not express an opinion or provide any assurance on RSI.

- 1) Management's Discussion and Analysis
- 2) Schedule of Measure R Apportionments and Allocations

We have been engaged to report on supplementary information other than RSI that accompanies the Authority's financial statements. Our responsibility for this supplementary information, as described by professional standards, is to evaluate the presentation of the supplementary information in relation to the financial statements as a whole and to report on whether the supplementary information is fairly stated, in all material respects, in relation to the financial statements as a whole:

- 1) Schedule of Measure R Apportionments and Allocations

Planned Scope and Timing of the Audit

An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements; therefore, our audit will involve judgment about the number of transactions to be examined and the areas to be tested.

Our audit will include obtaining an understanding of the Authority and its environment, including internal control, sufficient to assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements and to design the nature, timing, and extent of further audit procedures. Material misstatements may result from (1) errors, (2) fraudulent financial reporting, (3) misappropriation of assets, or (4) violations of laws or governmental regulations that are attributable to the Authority or to acts by management or employees acting on behalf of the Authority. We will generally communicate our significant findings at the conclusion of the audit. However, some matters could be communicated sooner, particularly if significant difficulties are encountered during the audit where assistance is needed to overcome the difficulties or if the difficulties may lead to a modified opinion. We will also communicate any internal control related matters that are required to be communicated under professional standards.

We expect to begin our audit on approximately August 2, 2021, and to issue our report no later than December 31, 2021. Rosalva Flores is the engagement partner and is responsible for supervising the engagement and signing the report or authorizing another individual to sign it.
