HIGH SPEED RAIL TOUR INSTRUCTIONS

The Hanford Viaduct is an active construction site. The following are the instructions/requirements should you be selected to attend.

- ✓ After the conclusion of the Policy conference on May 1, Meet the High-Speed Rail Tour bus on the Acequia side of the Visalia Convention Center. The bus will depart at 2:15pm sharp. You must have a completed application, signed waiver and meet dress code requirements before boarding the bus. (Applications are only available and can be filled out at the opening policy conference mixer at McDermont X)
- ✓ You are required to wear pants that cover the ankles, wear a shirt or top that has sleeves and wear footwear that is a work type boot/shoe- no sandals, no crocs, no open toed shoes are permitted.
- ✓ A hard hat and visibility safety vest will be provided, and you must wear them.
- ✓ Please bring water with you, as this is an outdoor activity.
