



## Paratransit & Dial-A-Ride Services

Paratransit service, a shared-ride, advanced-reservation, origin-to-destination service, is provided to locations within the cities of Dinuba, Porterville, and Tulare. Service is available within ¼ mile of each local fixed route. The service is available to ADA-eligible individuals, as well as seniors (age 65+) and Medicare card holders. ADA-eligible passengers must receive certification through an application process. Paratransit provides same-day service to non-ADA passengers (seniors and Medicare card holders only) on a space available basis. The cities of Exeter and Farmersville currently receive paratransit service from the City of Visalia (Visalia Transit).

Paratransit services operate the same hours and days as TCRTA’s local fixed route system; service is provided Monday through Saturday from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, and Sunday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Next day reservations are required and are taken seven days a week.

TCRTA also provides additional Dial-A-Ride service to seniors, the disabled, and Medicare card holders in other areas of the County with limited commuter routes, or no fixed route service. These areas include the City of Lindsay, North County communities (including Cutler and Orosi), and South County communities (including Waukena, Tipton, Pixley, Teviston, Alpaugh, Allensworth, Earlimart, and Richgrove). General-public Dial-A-Ride service is provided in the City of Woodlake. No next day reservations are required in Woodlake. Service hours vary by service area.

To provide reasonable accommodation on TCRTA's commuter system, ADA-eligible riders may request a route deviation pick-up and/or drop-off within  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile of commuter routes C10–C90, the Dinuba Connection, and route T11X. The service is available to ADA-eligible individuals, as well as seniors (age 65+) and Medicare card holders. Curb-to-curb service is provided unless a request is made for door-to-door service. Paratransit service is only provided by TCRTA for the portions of commuter routes that fall within its service area (not within the City of Visalia, or neighboring counties).

Deviated fixed route services operate the same hours and days as TCRTA's commuter fixed route system. Service hours vary by route. Next day reservations are required and are taken seven days a week. Reservations are accepted the day of the trip, provided there is room in the day's schedule to accommodate them.
